

## Covid Protocol ABLT – Feb. 12-13, 2022

### Oval Requirements

- Attendance is restricted to the maximum capacity of 100 (Sprint Pads) + 500 for Event (Oval Surface) + 500 Spectator stands for the Event Premises. Spectators are limited to one parent per athlete in the infield. As a result, approximately half the field will be skating in the morning, while the other half in the afternoon.
- All athletes, coaches, volunteers & spectators are asked to review the University's **Visitor Guidelines**.
- Proof of full vaccination (Alberta QR Code) is required for all guests over 12 accessing the Oval. Those over 18 years of age will be required to also show government issued identification.
- Masks are mandatory at all times while inside the Oval. Masks may only be removed for the purpose of eating, drinking **and during training and racing**.
- Social distancing is encouraged wherever possible; signage for closed areas is to be respected.
- Spitting and nose rockets are unacceptable; offenders will be asked to leave the Oval.
- Spectator viewing is from the stands; parents are requested to leave the infield once their child is ready for the ice.

### Parents & Skaters Attending ABLT

- As much as possible, we will operate on a one athlete: one parent ratio. Once skaters are ready for their race, parents are asked to remain in the stands, physically distanced from each other and wearing their masks at all times. Parents are asked not to consume food or drinks inside the Oval. A second parent is permitted to attend ABLT and remain in the stands.
- **Please remember to complete [the CSSA COVID-19 screening form](https://calgaryspeedskating.ca) – required for all persons entering the Oval.** Health assessments are required prior to each day (<https://calgaryspeedskating.ca> – click on red tab which is the Covid-19 screening form). Please show your green screen to volunteer at Oval entrance every day.
- Once vaccination status is shown to Oval guest services, bracelets will be provided to participants, volunteers & spectators to speed up Oval access.
- **Awards:** Medals will be set-up and skaters will be asked to pick-up and put on their own medal before stepping on the podium (with their mask on).
- **Armbands for Olympic style races:** Skaters are encouraged to bring their own armbands, if they have some.

### Officials & Volunteers

- Food will be provided in Room 54. Food will be individually wrapped or served by one designated volunteer only. Officials and volunteers are asked not to touch any food unless it is handed over to them.
- To enable social distancing while eating, dressing rooms A & B will be set-up to allow officials & volunteers to eat in a safer manner.
